Please be aware that this worksheet only accounts for the minimum credits to graduate. Additional courses are recommended for college bound students and some colleges will require additional credits for entrance. It is the parent's responsibility to contact the college your student plans to attend. Students pursuing a vocational track should take electives which focus on their particular area of interest. The minimum number of credits a student may earn in one year is five. The maximum number of credits a student may earn in one year is eight. One credit equals the completion of a high school level text (or higher) or a minimum of 130 hours of study for PE or Fine Art credits. Any student planning to complete all graduation requirements in less than four years must give written notice and submit an approved IEP by the end of their sophomore year.																
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
