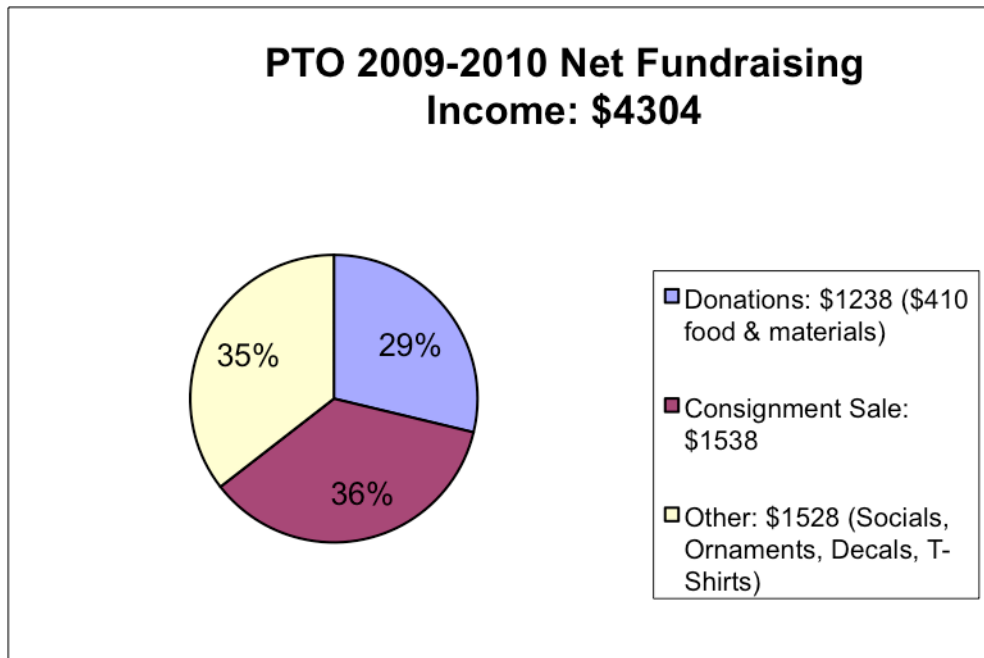
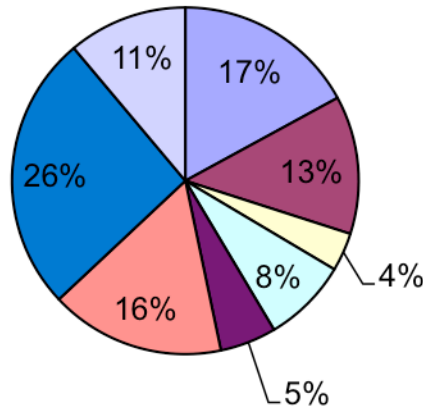


PTO Meeting Notes from August 25, 2010

1. Welcome / Opening Prayer / Sign-In
2. Introduction of Officers: Sue Morris (co-chair, treasurer), Stacey Rodriguez (co-chair, absent), & Jennifer Shaw (secretary)
3. PTO webpage lists all contact information and organizational goals (promoting communication, school spirit, fellowship, learning, and teacher appreciation), and it can be accessed under "MCS Family" submenu
4. Budget Discussion
 - a. Difference between Net Fundraising and Non-Fundraiser Expense was \$1373. PTO intended to charge for fundraisers only what was required to cover expenses. We cover a \$500 Senior Scholarship during the summer. In addition, PTO was originally to give a 50% on T-Shirt Profit to Booster Club. We gained \$450 on account because Mr. Slater and Shalee graciously suspended agreement due to change in dress code. Thank you Mr. Slater and Shalee for your support of PTO!



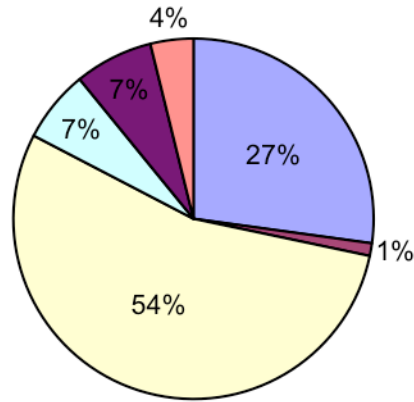

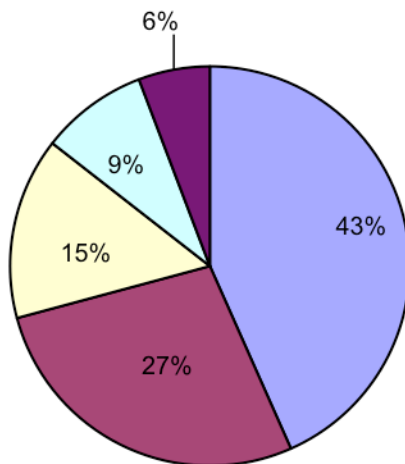
- b. Separate Pennies for PTO account raised \$4872. All BB Court money was used in construction. About \$479 is leftover from money raised for playground after 3 red umbrellas were purchased. Practically all 2007 money raised for courtyard has been spent.
- c. This year's general budget for events has a little over \$800, after \$500 senior scholarship was deducted.
- d. Last year the PTO membership and the school board approved adding a \$5 fee to each student's tuition. That money is tracked in an account separate from any other PTO event budget funds and will be used this year specifically for efforts that support ALL students. The 346 students enrolled raised \$1730, and will be used as shown in the pie chart for teacher appreciation, both field days, education events, and the PTOToday Plus membership website access fee.
