

TUITION ASSISTANCE

KINDERGARTEN THROUGH TWELFTH GRADE



It is our desire to make a Christ-centered, education available to as many families as possible. Each year, Maryville Christian School allocates a limited amount of funds for tuition assistance to enrolled families. All tuition assistance awards are based on demonstrated need and is assessed through an independent third-party program, **FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment**.

The principles below are followed in the tuition assistance process:

HOW TO APPLY

You may apply for the following tuition assistance after you have accepted to Maryville Christian School.

- **FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment** - please visit the website at <https://online.factsmgt.com/aid> to create an account. By completing the online FACTS, your information will be provided to Maryville Christian School in a timely manner. The FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment website will lead you through the completion process and will also indicate additional documentation required for the assessment process.
 - Complete the online application
 - Submit payment of \$35 non-refundable application fee. After completing the online application, you will be instructed to fax supporting documentation to FACTS.
- Tuition assistance awards are available for kindergarten – grade 12. Awards are granted only after your child has been accepted to Maryville Christian School and the **application | enrollment fee** has been paid.
- A completed FACTS Grant & Aid application is due at time of enrollment.
- All aspects of the tuition assistance process for your family are confidential. The FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment procedures are detailed on FACTS Grant & Aid. Information provided to the finance office is handled in strictest confidence; and we require that tuition assistance awards to your family remain confidential between you and the school.
- Tuition assistance awards will not exceed 50 percent of tuition. Parents are responsible for the remaining tuition balance and all fees.
- Families must reapply for tuition assistance awards each year using the same assessment process. Due to changes in family financial situations and the tuition assistance resources available at the school, families may receive awards that are greater or lower than the previous year.
- As an independent school, student-athletes do not receive preferential treatment in the awards of tuition assistance. No student may receive any form of tuition assistance in exchange for athletic participation.
- Tuition assistance awards will be made without regard to race, color, nationality, or ethnic origin.

DISCOUNTS_(not available for preschool)

1. **Pastor Discount (NEW):** 25% saving for full-time ordained pastor of a 501c3 church.
2. **Sibling Discount:** 10% for the second child, 20% discount for the third child, FREE for the fourth child, and 50% each child beyond the fourth (or more). Full tuition is paid for the oldest student and the discount applies to each additional enrolled sibling.
3. **Alumni Discount (NEW):** 25% savings for children of alumni who graduated from MCS.

***Pastor discount, sibling discount, and alumni discount cannot be stacked or combined with each other.**

*** Tuition does not include the cost of retreats, mission trips and other activities, Students taking dual enrollment will be asked to cover the cost of the course and textbooks.**
