



Umbrella Testing Options

IOWA Testing is required for 2nd - 8th Grade

In person Testing - IOWA Standardized Test (Traditional Paper/ #2 Pencil test)

- Wednesday, March 22 - Friday, March 24, 2023
- 2nd- 4th, 6th-8th grade will test on Wednesday and Thursday only
- 5th grade will test all three days (Friday testing is the additional CogAT)
- Practice testing can be ordered upon request for 1st - 3rd grade and at an additional cost.

At Home - On-line Testing - IOWA - BJU Press

- You will schedule your testing at home through BJU Press online
- Schedule your testing for dates convenient for your family
- After testing you will submit scores to HSU Coordinator

ISP Testing Options

All students in the ISP are required to test once per year.

Pre-ACT, PSAT, CLT10 (9th -10th grade options)

- PSAT - Fall testing at MCS with on-campus students
- PreACT - Spring testing at MCS with on-campus students
- CLT10 - This is an at home on-line test (Additional College readiness test) <https://www.cltexam.com/>

SAT & ACT (10th-12th grade)

- Students in grades 11-12 should take the ACT or SAT each year by registering directly with the testing agency (www.act.org and collegeboard.org respectively).

Note:

1. **All families that choose to test at home will be responsible to turn in all test scores for your child's records.**
2. **Testing fees for in-person testing, including PreACT and PSAT, will be billed after registration deadline.**
