



## **Umbrella Testing Options**

### **IOWA Testing is required for 2nd - 8th Grade**

#### **In person Testing - IOWA Standardized Test (Traditional Paper/ #2 Pencil test)**

- 2nd- 4th, 6th-8th grade will test on Wednesday and Thursday only
- 5th grade will test all three days (Friday testing is the additional CogAT)
- Optional Practice test for 1st grader will be on Thursday (\$25)

#### **At Home - On-line Testing - IOWA - BJU Press**

- You will schedule your testing at home through BJU Press online
- Schedule your testing for dates convenient for your family
- After testing you will submit scores to HSU Coordinator

## **ISP Testing Options**

**All students in the ISP are required to test once per year, unless they have scored the graduation minimum of 17 on ACT and will not be pursuing a college degree.**

#### **Pre-ACT, CLT10 (9th -10th grade options)**

- PreACT - Fall testing at MCS with on-campus students
- CLT10 - This is an at home on-line test (Additional College readiness test)

#### **SAT & ACT (10th-12th grade)**

- Students in grades 11-12 should take the ACT or SAT each year by registering directly with the testing agency ([www.act.org](http://www.act.org) and [collegeboard.org](http://collegeboard.org) respectively).
