**Classroom Academic Support**

Classroom teachers provide after school academic support and homework help for all students until 3:45. There is no charge for this support.

**Backpack and Agenda Check**

This provides support for students who may need extra assistance with organization. This program is designed to provide accountability and build independence for our students in grades 3-12. Students "check-out" through the Backpack & Agenda Check before leaving the school building each day.

**Double Dose Reading Intervention**

This program is designed for kindergarten – 6th grade students. Double Dose includes 30 extra minutes of reading instruction by our reading specialists in addition to reading, language arts, and spelling in the classroom. The goal is to improve phonemic awareness, phonetics, fluency, comprehension, and vocabulary instruction.

**Level 1**

The accommodations for Level One include extended time to complete assignments and tests, use of calculator, preferential seating, and allowing the use of a computer/iPad.

**Level 2**

Accommodations for Level Two may include but are not limited to reducing written assignments and/or questions on a test, breaking assignments into smaller units, providing a copy of notes, providing a word bank for tests, providing assistance with assignments, providing visual cues or organizers, and assistance with formulas.

**Level 3**

Level Three may have accommodations from the first two levels but will also include having tests or assignments read to the student, ability for the student to leave the classroom to take tests or quizzes, modified format of tests or quizzes, study hall assistance separate from peers, the ability to use a scribe, review or reteach options, and the option to retest (under certain circumstances).

**Billing**
